Statewide...

We are calling on Governor Cuomo; NYS Assembly & Senate to:

Follow NYC in divesting public pension funds from the fossil fuel industry.

We are calling on Mayor Bill de Blasio; NYC Council to:

Bolster current efforts to [achieve an 80% reduction of CO₂ emissions by 2050](#), especially by focusing on improving energy efficiency in city buildings.
